Notes/Action Plan:

Install IAQ provided pre-filters and tracks on ALL headers

Secure or fasten inlet plates (tek-screws).

Inspect header model #1875 gauge tubing (clean and clear).

Wash customer's spent cassettes and instruct on how to surface clean the front face of cassettes.

Moly/Phosphate coating is creating a "sludge" like contaminant on the face of the fiber bed filters; the IAQ provided pre-filter c/w mounting track should eliminate the fiber bed filters from "face loading".

Tentative action date for completion with IAQ technicians - September 16th, 2008.

IAQ techs to involve ATS contacts Cory Ross or Stan Sparks with service oversight/supervision.

ATS/CAT to provide assistance with pressure washing equipment and forklifts/area to wash spent filters.
